FORENSIC INTERVIEWER



Job Description: The Forensic Interviewer conducts forensic interviews of children who are involved in a child maltreatment investigation that includes allegations of sexual or physical abuse, or are a witness to sexual or physical abuse or domestic violence. Forensic Interviewers will coordinate with other child service workers and be expected to provide case reviews, maintain case files and tracking, legal involvement and testimony. In addition, this position will provide community education and outreach regarding child abuse awareness and prevention. This is a full-time position. On-call time and travel within service area is expected.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree required in sociology, human services, social work, business or related field and two years of experience in a child welfare setting; or, any equivalent combination of experience and/or education from which comparable knowledge, skills and abilities have been achieved. Demonstrated evidence of a team-oriented, professional mindset with the experience and ability to collaborate with other agencies. Ability to multitask and show attention to detail in a fast-paced professional environment. Previous experience with forensic interviewing is beneficial, but not required.

Salary: Commensurate with education and experience.
